



Mary Blair contacted EYG after moving into her newbuild home in Yorkshire and realising she did not have enough space to host dinners for family and friends.


Her home did not have a designated area big enough for a large table and chairs, and therefore she decided to extend with an orangery.



Edwardian

Add a touch of elegance to your home with an Edwardian conservatory – ideal for maximising the floor space in both modern and period properties.

Edwardian conservatories are symmetrical and often square or rectangular, and traditionally include large glass panels which create very light and airy rooms which are flooded wth natural light. The Edwardian style allows you to maximise your enjoyment and usage of the extra space created.

If you want a Victorian look for a period home, then we have a beautiful selection of Victorian conservatories featuring ornate cresting and finials.



Gableend

A gable end conservatory has a roof that stands upright like the end of a house, instead of sloping inwards towards the centre of the room. This gives it a very appealing look from both inside and out, creating extra height from inside the conservatory but also giving the impression of grandeur from the outside.

This style works well with period homes, having the look and feel of an old-style orangery which was popular in maginificent country houses of old.

Lean to

A lean to conservatory remains one of our best sellers - offering a contemporary look for the rear of any property and acting as a quick, easy and cheaper alternative to a traditional brick home extension.

A design classic and probably the most cost-effective way to add another room to your home, the lean-to conservatory can have either a polycarbonate, glass or tiled conservatory roof.

Whether you want to use the space as a garden room, dining room, play room, home office or extra living room for everyone to enjoy, its simple rectangular shape will ensure that you can use every inch of available floor space. A sensible but stylish option when a small conservatory is required.







Pshaped

Ideal for detached houses and larger homes, the P-shaped conservatory is guaranteed to add a feeling of luxury and grandeur. The P-shape combines both a lean to conservatory with a Victorian style and can have three or five sides, depending on the size of the house. The P-shaped conservatory can vary in size, and be finished with a style of doors including patio, French or bifold doors and any solid, tiled, glass or hybrid conservatory roof.

Constructed by combining the best elements of a lean-to conservatory and a Victorian conservatory, the 'P' shape it creates is very spacious. Because the P-shaped conservatory extends in several different directions, it can be used for a combination of purposes and is particularly popular with families who want a combined dining area and living space.

We had a depleted budget to achieve their dream plan, therefore we recommended a new conservatory which was cheaper than a brick-built extension. We suggested an insulated Hybrid roof – which had alternating solid and glass panels - along with insulated walls and flooring as well, which all combined to give the look and feel of an extension, with the same thermal efficiency.

The judges described the project as "outstanding".





Garage Conversions

Garage conversions provide a relatively cheap and easy solution if you want to gain a considerable amount of new entertaining or living space without building a new home extension from scratch.


